

Make a Natural Christmas Decoration



Reindeer

TOP TIP

Each snowflake is unique so make yours different by adding glitter or colourful ribbon and thread.

What you need

- Twigs / sticks (clean and dry)
- Garden twine or cotton thread
- Blu Tack, PVA glue or a glue gun
- 2 x googly eyes, a red pom-pom & one star

What to do

Reindeer - Make an A shape out of three twigs and fix together. Turn it upside down and stick down two googly eyes and a red pom-pom. Then tie some twine or thread to the middle. *Tip: Use twiggly sticks to make it look more like antlers.*

Snowflake - Take three sticks about the same size and make an asterisk. Stick them together in the middle, then tie some twine around it. Take six small twigs about 2cm long, bend each in the middle to make a V and stick them about a 1cm from the end of each twig. Then tie some twine or thread around the end of one twig.

Tree - Place one slightly thicker, longer twig vertically. Then take 8 twigs of different lengths and order them from longest to shortest along the main twig leaving about an inch at the bottom, then stick each down. Tie some twine or thread to the top and attach a star.

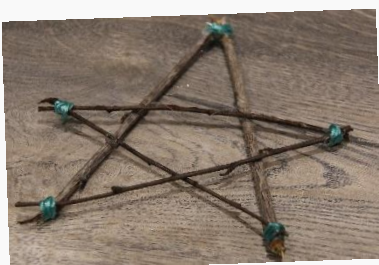
Star - Find five twigs about the same size. Take two, make a V and secure them together with glue or tac at the point. Then stick another across the V about 1/3 of the way up. Make a cross with the two remaining sticks and attach them to the ends of the other sticks to make a star shape.
