



Noughty 90s Music Festival

Leazes Park - Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th August 2023

Dear Residents & Businesses,

This letter is to advise you of the forthcoming music festival Noughty 90's Festival taking place at Leazes Park on Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th August 2023.

About the Noughty 90's Festival

Noughty 90's is a music festival that is expected to bring the biggest 00's and 90's bands, artists and DJ's to Newcastle in the Summer. The event is a fully ticketed that must be booked in advance. The 2-day event will have an array of 90's and 00's music. The festival will include a range of food stalls, a licensed bar and fun fair rides.

Event dates and timings are as follows:

Build and Breakdown of the Festival

The festival build will commence on Monday 21st August 2023 until the event opens on Saturday 26th August 2023. The festival breakdown will finish on Thursday 31st August at 17:00. For health and safety and / or security purposes, certain areas of the park will need to be restricted / closed during this time.

Location, park facilities and access routes

The event will take place around the bandstand and top field of the park. From Monday 21st August - Thursday 31st August 2023, this area will be closed off to park users. However, the main park facilities will remain open to the public including the tennis courts, basketball courts, maze, Tower Café, the lake, children's play area, picnic area by the café and play area.

Sound checks

Minimal sounds may be heard on Friday 25th August from 10:00 – 18:00 with the main sound checks taking place on Saturday from 10:00 – 12:00.

Noise Control

Noise control measures have been formulated to minimise noise disturbance for local residents. The event organisers have appointed a sound management contractor to work with them and Newcastle City Council to agree sound levels and ensure the agreed sound levels are adhered to throughout the event. Traffic and Transport Management

The event organiser aim's to minimise the disturbance and inconvenience from people going to and from Leazes Park attending the festival and other park user, and have a set plan for this which includes:

- The festival entrance / exit will be via Barrack Road

- Based on analysis of ticket holders' postcode data, it is anticipated that the vast majority of the audience will travel to site on public transport
- Event organisers have been engaging with Nexus to build insight from station managers and previous events into the plans for managing ingress and egress, which will be stress-tested through the council safety group planning process.
- Crowds leaving the event will be directed to ensure the shortest route is taken to leave the park and their chosen transport hub. Attendees will also be instructed to leave in a quiet and orderly manner mindful of local residents.
- There will be a road land closure on Barrack Road at certain times – see below.

Refuse and Waste Management

A refuse team will be employed before, during and after the event by the event organiser. Urban Green Newcastle will also carry out a separate cleaning services within the park after the event.

Road Closures

There will be a lane closed on Barrack Road on Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th August from 21:30 – 23:00.
