Why join us?

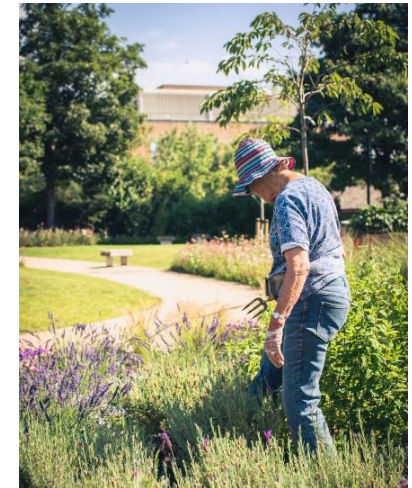
