Vegetable Classes

1. **Newcastle Challenge Cup:** 2 pot leeks 150mm (6") to tight button.
2. 1 intermediate leek between 200mm and 300mm (8" and 12")
3. 2 blanch leeks above (14")
4. **Salad Collection:** choose any 4 vegetables out of the following.

(The number shown in brackets, is the quantity needed of each chosen vegetable.)

- a. Globe beetroot (3)
 - b. Tomatoes (3)
 - c. Golden ball turnip (2)
 - d. Stump carrots (2)
 - e. Cucumber (1)
 - f. Potatoes (3)
 - g. Peppers (3)
 - h. Courgettes (3)
 - i. Aubergines (3)
 - j. Red onion (1)
 - k. Lettuce (2)
 - l. Bunch of radishes (10)
 - m. Spring onions (10)
5. 1 plate of 3 onions dressed
 6. 1 heavy onion to be shown as grown
 7. 1 plate of 3 complete garlic bulbs
 8. 2 ears of sweetcorn as grown
 9. 1 head of celery white/pink



10. 1 vegetable marrow
11. 2 long parsnips cut to 100mm (4") of foliage.
12. 3 stump carrots
13. 2 long carrots
14. 2 long beetroot
15. 2 globe beetroots
16. 1 summer turnip
17. 1 red cabbage
18. 1 plate of 6 potatoes of one colour/variety
19. 1 plate of 6 pods runner beans
20. 1 plate of 6 pods peas
21. 1 cucumber
22. 1 plate of 6 heritage/unusual variety tomatoes
23. 1 plate of tomatoes on the vine
24. 1 plate of cherry or plum tomatoes
25. 3 rhubarb sticks

28. Soft fruit, 1 plate of 12

34. 1 vase of 3 roses, large flowered, any colour, any variety
35. 1 bowl or vase of mixed flowers arranged

Novelty Classes

36. Biggest pumpkin (measured by circumference)
37. Best Patio or Container Planter
38. Most unusual variety of fruit or vegetable grown on an allotment
39. Best garden (including balcony, vertical gardens) photograph up to A4
in size
40. A drawing or painting of your choice
